A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT SOLICITATION OF BALLOT ISSUE PETITION SIGNATURES ON ELECTION DAY AND PROVIDING A PENALTY; AMENDING SECTION 13-35-233, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 13-35-233, MCA, is amended to read:

"13-35-233. Solicitation of ballot issue petition signatures or votes on election day. (1) It is unlawful for a person or a political committee to solicit ballot issue petition signatures on election day within any polling place or any building within which an election is being held or within 200 feet thereof or place an advertisement supporting or opposing a candidate or a ballot issue for use on election day. Failure to remove billboards, yard signs, or posters on election day is not considered a violation.

(2) A person convicted of solicitation of votes or ballot issue petition signatures on election day is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be imprisoned in the county jail for a term not to exceed 6 months or be fined not to exceed \$1,000, or both."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 13-35-233, MCA, is amended to read:

"13-35-233. Solicitation of ballot issue petition signatures or votes on election day. (1) It is unlawful for a person or a political committee to solicit ballot issue petition signatures on election day within any polling place or any building within which an election is being held or within 200 feet thereof or place an advertisement supporting or opposing a candidate or a ballot issue for use on election day. Failure to remove billboards, yard signs, or posters on election day is not considered a violation.

(2) A person convicted of solicitation of votes or ballot issue petition signatures on election day is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be imprisoned in the county jail for a term not to exceed 6 months or be fined not to exceed \$1,000, or both."
