In compliance with a written request received <u>January 14</u> , 19 81, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note
for Senate Bill 108 pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA).
Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members
of the Legislature upon request.

Description of Proposed Legislation:

Senate Bill 108 amends Section 85-2-224, M.C.A., to provide for the application of the filing fee for a statement of claim for an existing water right by specifically including multiple uses.

Assumptions:

There will be 300,000 claims received during the entire filing period. Of these, 225,000 will be received during FY 1982. No claims will be filed beyond the current deadline of January 1, 1982.

If the proposed legislation is retroactive to the beginning of the claim filing period, the total reduction in expected revenue will be approximately $\frac{\$3,780,000}{\$3,780,000}$. This figure reflects \$2,520,000 lost in FY 1982 and an estimated \$1,260,000 reduction in expected revenue for FY 1981.

Public re-education will be necessary. Claim forms will need to be redesigned, printed and distributed. Refunds totaling \$100,000 will be made on already filed claims.
