in existence, which shall be suitable for use for
commercial, manufacturing, agricultural, or industrial
enterprises; recreation or tourist facilities; local,
state, and federal governmental facilities; multifamily

facilities; small-scale hydroelectric production facilities
with a capacity of 80 megawatts or less; and any combination
