BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 77-3-427, MCA, is amended to read:

"77-3-427. Provision for offset wells == compensatory
regalties. Oil and gas leases granted by the state shall
contain suitable provisions imposing upon all lessees the
obligation to drill offset wells wherever and whenever
necessary to prevent waste and damage to the property of the
state. The board may allow the lessee the option of paying
a compensatory regalty in lieu of drilling an offset well if
it determines that such compensatory regalty will fully
compensate the state for waste and damage to the property of
the state. The compensatory regalty shall be based upon the
estimated drainage: as determined by the board: and shall be
paid on a monthly basis unless circumstances require

Description of Proposed Legislation:

An act to provide for compensatory royalties in lieu of offset drilling on State oil and gas leases; Amending Section 77-3-427, MCA.

Comments:

No additional expenses will be incurred by the enactment of this legislation. Any additional work will be absorbed by present staff.

Revenues are not expected to increase because of the passage of this legislation. The department would either receive royalties from the offset wells, as we do now, or receive compensatory royalty in lieu of drilling.
