In compliance with a written request received <u>January 20</u> , 19 <u>81</u> , there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note
for <u>Senate Bill 166</u> pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA).
Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members
of the Legislature upon request.

#### Description of Proposed Legislation

Senate Bill 166 increases assessments to fund the Pork Research and Marketing Committee from 10c to 20c per head on all swine sold. It also deletes the requirement to pay 10% of net revenue to the National Meat Board and increases the amount paid to the National Pork Council from 10% to 50% of net revenue.

#### Assumptions

- 1. There will be 300,000 hogs sold each year.
- 2. All fees will be collected and there will be no refunds.

### Fiscal Impact

Revenue from the sale of 300,000 hogs under current law is \$30,000; under proposed law is \$60,000.
