4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING SECTION  
5 5-2-103, MCA, TO PROVIDE THAT THE LEGISLATURE SHALL MEET IN  
6 ANNUAL SESSIONS FOR 8 CONSECUTIVE 6-DAY WEEKS IF THE  
7 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO SO PROVIDE PASSES; PROVIDING AN  
8 EFFECTIVE DATE."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
11 Section 1. Section 5-2-103, MCA, is amended to read:  
12 "5-2-103. Time and place of meeting. Each regular  
13 session of the legislature shall be convened at the seat of  
14 government at 12 noon on the first Monday of the first week  
15 after New Year's Day January of each odd-numbered year, or  
16 if--January--is--a--Monday--on--the--first--Wednesday. Each  
17 regular legislative session shall run for 8 consecutive  
18 6-day weeks. The legislature shall meet at other times when  
19 convened by the governor or by the written request of a  
20 majority of the legislators or, when the legislature is in  
21 session, by a recorded vote of a majority of the  
22 legislators."

23 Section 2. Effective date. This act becomes effective  
24 on the same date that the amendment to Article V, section 6,  
25 of the Montana Constitution providing that the legislature

1 shall meet in annual sessions for 8 consecutive 6-day weeks  
2 becomes effective.
