11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 Section 1. Section 2-15-1614, MCA, is amended to read

13 "2-15-1614. Board of radiologic technologists. (1

14 There is a board of radiologic technologists.

15 (2) The board consists of seven members appointed by

16 the governor:

17 (a) two members shall be radiologists licensed to

18 practice medicine in Montana;

19 (b) one member shall be a physician--licensed--to

20 practice--medicine--in--Montana person granted an unlimited

21 permit issued by the board pursuant to 37-14-306;

22 (c) one member shall be a chiropractor licensed to

23 practice in Montana; and

24 (d) three members shall be radiologic technologists

25 registered with the American registry of radiologic

1 technologists (ARRT) who, with the exception of the first
2 appointed members, are licensed radiologic technologists.

4 (3) Vacancies in unexpired terms shall be filled for
5 the remainder of the term.

7 (4) Each member shall serve for a term of 3 years.

9 (5) The board is allocated to the department for
10 administrative purposes only as prescribed in 2-15-121.*

12 Section 2. Section 37-14-302, MCA, is amended to read:

14 "37-14-302. Qualifications. (1) Each applicant for
15 licensure as a radiologic technologist--other--than--those
16 qualifying--under--37-14-312, shall have satisfactorily
17 completed a 24-month course of study in radiologic
18 technology approved by the board.

21 technologist--including--these--qualifying--under--37-14-312,

28 (c) not be addicted to intemperate use of alcohol or
