9 Section 1. Section 85-15-304, MCA, is amended to read:  
10 "85-15-304. Penalties. Any person violating any of the  
11 provisions of this chapter is punishable by a fine not to  
12 exceed ~~\$500~~ \$50,000 or imprisonment in the county jail for a  
13 term not to exceed 6 months, or both. ~~if death ensues by~~  
14 ~~reason of any of the acts prohibited by this chapter, the~~  
15 ~~person guilty of the same may be convicted of homicides"~~
