11 "85-15-304. Penalties. Any person violating any of the
12 provisions of this chapter is punishable by a fine not to
13 exceed \$500 ~~\$50,000~~ or imprisonment in the county jail for a
14 term not to exceed 6 months, or both. If death ensues by
15 reason of any of the acts prohibited by this chapter, the
person guilty of the same may be convicted of homicide."
