4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ANY  
5 SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT CONDUCTS PUPIL-INSTRUCTION DAYS BEFORE  
6 LABOR DAY IS NOT ENTITLED TO RECEIVE SCHOOL EQUALIZATION  
7 APPORTIONMENT FUNDS FOR THOSE DAYS; AND PROVIDING AN  
8 EFFECTIVE DATE."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Conducting pupil-instruction days before  
12 Labor Day -- reduction in annual apportionment entitlement.  
13 Any district that conducts pupil-instruction days before  
14 Labor Day, the first Monday in September, is not entitled to  
15 receive school equalization apportionment funds for those  
16 days. If the district fails to conduct the minimum 180  
17 school days required for entitlement of equalization  
18 apportionment after Labor Day but otherwise conducts 180  
19 days or more for the school year, the superintendent of  
20 public instruction shall reduce the equalization  
21 apportionment of the district for the year by 1/180th for  
22 each pupil-instruction day conducted before Labor Day.

23 Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is  
24 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 20,  
25 chapter 1, part 3, and the provisions of Title 20 apply to

2 Section 3. Effective date. This act is effective on  
3 July 1, 1981.
