A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 75-10-214, MCA, TO ALLOW CERTAIN CONTROLLED BURNING FOR TRAINING FIREFIGHTERS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 75-10-214, MCA, is amended to read:

"75-10-214. Exclusions -- exceptions to exclusions.

(1) (a) This part may not be construed to prohibit a person from disposing of his own solid waste, except hazardous waste, upon land owned or leased by that person or covered by easement or permit as long as it does not create a nuisance or public health hazard.

(b) A person may dispose of his own hazardous wastes upon land owned or leased by that person or covered by easement or permit after complying with the licensing requirements of this part and the rules adopted to regulate the disposal or transport of hazardous wastes.

(c) The exclusion contained in subsection (1)(a) of this section does not apply to a division of land of 5 acres or less made after July 1, 1977, which falls within the definition of subdivision in Title 76, chapter 4, part 1, or the Montana Subdivision and Platting Act in Title 76,

(2) The licensing requirements of this part do not apply to the transportation of marketable hazardous wastes to a manufacturing or processing center.

~~(3) This part does not prohibit a municipality or county from stockpiling waste lumber, trees, scrubs, or other wooden waste materials and burning these materials at specified and controlled locations under the direction of the local fire department for the purpose of training firefighters."~~
