8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 75-10-214. MCA, is amended to read:
10 "75-10-214. Exclusions -- exceptions to exclusions.
11 (1) (a) This part may not be construed to prohibit a person
12 from disposing of his own solid waste, except hazardous
13 waste, upon land owned or leased by that person or covered
14 by easement or permit as long as it does not create a
15 nuisance or public health hazard.

16 (b) A person may dispose of his own hazardous wastes 17 upon land owned or leased by that person or covered by 18 easement or permit after complying with the licensing 19 requirements of this part and the rules adopted to regulate 20 the disposal or transport of hazardous wastes.

(c) The exclusion contained in subsection (1)(a) of
this section does not apply to a division of land of 5 acres
or less made after July 1, 1977, which falls within the
definition of subdivision in Title 76, chapter 4, part 1, or
the Montana Subdivision and Platting Act in Title 76,

1 chapter 3.

(2) The licensing requirements of this part do not
apply to the transportation of marketable hazardous wastes
to a manufacturing or processing center.
