THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND CONSERVATION

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE INCURRING OF LIABILITIES AND EXPENSES WHEN AN ENERGY SUPPLY ALERT OR AN EMERGENCY OR DISASTER ARISING FROM AN ENERGY SHORTAGE IS DECLARED BY THE GOVERNOR; AMENDING SECTIONS 10-3-311 AND 90-4-318. MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 10-3-311, MCA, is amended to read:

"10-3-311. Emergency or disaster expenditures. (1) The governor may authorize the incurring of liabilities and expenses to be paid as other claims against the state from the general fund, in the amount necessary, when an emergency or disaster justifies the expenditure and is declared by the governor, to meet contingencies and emergencies arising from energy. Shortages: hostile attacks, riots or insurrections, epidemics of disease, plaques of insects, fires, floods, or other acts of God resulting in damage or disaster to the works, buildings or property of the state or any political subdivision thereof or which menace the health, welfare, safety, lives, or property of any considerable number of

persons in any county or community of the state, upon
demonstration by the political jurisdiction that:

- 3 (a) such political jurisdiction has exhausted all 4 available emergency levies;
- (b) the emergency is beyond the financial capability
  of the political jurisdiction to respond and for which no
  appropriation is available in sufficient amount to meet the
  emergency or disaster; or
- 9 (c) federal funds available for such emergency or
  10 disaster require either matching state funds or specific
  11 expenditures prior to eligibility for assistance under
  12 federal laws.
- 13 (2) The governor shall be charged with the 14 implementation of the program.

(3) The administration and development of rules for implementation of this section will be promulgated by the department of administration.

Section 2. Section 90-4-318, MCA, is amended to read:

#90-4-318. Governor may authorize expenditure. The
governor may authorize the incurring of liabilities and
expenses to be paid as other claims against the state from
the general fund, in the amount necessary, when an energy
supply\_alert\_or\_an energy emergency is declared by the
governor and justifies the expenditure as set forth in
10-3-311 for other emergency or disaster expenditures.\*\*
