In compliance with a written request received <u>January 28</u>, <u>19</u>, <u>81</u>, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>Senate Bill 264</u> pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Senate Bill No. 264 would increase by two the number of round trips per session for which legislators would be allowed to be reimbursed.

ASSUMPTIONS:

The legislature is reimbursed for 56,450 miles for each round trip authorized.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Each round trip for the entire legislature costs \$11,290. Two additional round trips would cost \$22580.
