Description of Proposed Legislation: "An act to increase the amount of money that a discharged inmate may receive; amending Section 53-30-111, MCA."

Assumptions:

- 1) This legislation permits the Department of Institutions to increase separation allowances to \$100. It does not require the Department to do so.
- 2) The State Prison's budget request for the '82-'83 biennium is based on existing statutes, at a \$25 maximum.
- 3) The Prison will expend only what is is appropriated for the biennium.

Fiscal Impact:

There will be no fiscal impact in the '82-'83 biennium, since the State Prison's budget request has been based on existing statutes.

Long-Range Effects:

Beginning with FY 1984, the implementation of this legislation could result in increased cost to the General Fund. The amount of the increase, if any, cannot be estimated, as it will be determined by the 1983 legislature.
