9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10                   Section 1. Section 46-18-203, MCA, is amended to read:

11                   "46-18-203. Revocation of suspended or deferred

12 sentence. A ~~judge--magistrate--or--justice--of--the--peace,~~

13 MAGISTRATE, OR JUSTICE OF THE PEACE who has suspended the

14 execution of a sentence or deferred the imposition of a

15 sentence of imprisonment under 46-18-201 or his successor is

16 authorized, during the period of the suspended sentence or

17 deferred imposition of sentence, in his discretion, to

18 revoke the suspension or impose sentence and order the

19 person committed. He A DISTRICT JUDGE may also, in his

20 discretion, order the prisoner placed under the jurisdiction

21 of the ~~board--of--pardons~~ DEPARTMENT OF INSTITUTIONS as

22 provided by law or retain such jurisdiction with his court.

23 Prior to the revocation of an order suspending or deferring

24 the imposition of sentence, the person affected shall be

25 given a hearing."
