BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
Section 1. Section 46-18-203, MCA, is amended to read:
"46-18-203. Revocation of suspended or deferred
sentence. A ~~judge, magistrate, or justice of the peace~~ who
has suspended the execution of a sentence or deferred the
imposition of a sentence of imprisonment under 46-18-201 or
his successor is authorized, during the period of the
suspended sentence or deferred imposition of sentence, in
his discretion, to revoke the suspension or impose sentence
and order the person committed. He may also, in his
discretion, order the prisoner placed under the jurisdiction
of the board of pardons as provided by law or retain such
jurisdiction with his court. Prior to the revocation of an
order suspending or deferring the imposition of sentence,
the person affected shall be given a hearing."
