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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-12-2183, MCA, is amended to read:

"7-12-2183. Loan from revolving fund to meet payments
on bonds and warrants or to make emergency repairs. (1)
Whenever any rural special improvement district bond or
warrant or any interest thereon shall become due and payable
and there shall then be either no money or not sufficient
money in the appropriate district fund with which to pay the
same, an amount sufficient to make up the deficiency may, by
order of the board of county commissioners, be loaned by the
revolving fund to such district fund. Thereupon, such bond
or warrant or such interest thereon shall be paid from the
money so loaned or from the money so loaned when added to
such insufficient amount, as the case may require.

(2) Whenever any rural special improvement district maintenance fund does not have sufficient money to pay the cost of emergency repairs. the board of county commissioners

1 by order or resolution may loan money from the revolving
