8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
9 Section 1. Motor vehicles -- U.S. made. All motor
10 vehicles purchased after [the effective date of this act] by
11 the state of Montana must have been manufactured and
12 assembled in the United States.

13 Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is
14 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 18,
15 chapter 4, part 1, and the provisions of Title 18, chapter
16 4, apply to section 1.
