A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STATE TO
PURCHASE ONLY MOTOR VEHICLES MANUFACTURED AND ASSEMBLED IN
THE UNITED STATES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
Section 1. Motor vehicles -- U.S. made. All motor
vehicles purchased after [the effective date of this act] by
the state of Montana must have been manufactured and
assembled in the United States.
Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is
intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 18,
chapter 4, part 1, and the provisions of Title 18, chapter
4, apply to section 1.
