BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 11 Section 1. Section 60-3-214, MCA, is amended to read: 12 13 #60+3-214. Construction or reconstruction of bridges. 14 (1) The department may allocate from state construction moneys available for the federal-aid highway system up to \$1 15 million in any fiscal year for the construction or 16 17 reconstruction of any major bridge or system of bridges on 18 the primary or secondary highway systems. This may be done 19 only when the use of regularly apportioned funds would 20 prohibit or seriously delay the orderly and necessary highway construction program in the financial districts. 21

(2) When the department, as a part of its finding of 22 public necessity, declares that a particular bridge should 23 24 be constructed or reconstructed on a designated portion of 25 the primary or secondary highway, the allocation may be

made. The allocation may be expended: 1

(a) on primary bridges when the department's estimate 2 of the cost of construction or reconstruction is in excess 3 of \$500.000; 4

(b) on secondary bridges when the department's 5 estimate of the state's share of the cost of construction or 6 7 reconstruction is in excess of the total estimated future regular apportionment of state construction moneys to the 8 federal-aid secondary system of the county or counties for a 9 10 period of 3 years.

11 (3) The allocation shall be made from available state 12 construction moneys for the primary system before the apportionment in 60-3-205 and for the secondary system 13 14 before the apportionment in 60-3-206.

15 (4) The department may allocate from state 16 construction money available for the federal-aid highway 17 system_money__to__construct__a__bridge_located_outside_the boundaries of Montana if it determines. after an economic 18 19 analysis of the cost of construction and maintenance of the 20 bridge and the roads that adjoin it. that it is more 21 economical_to_construct_the_bridge_at_such_location_than_at 22

a location within the boundaries of Montana."
