A resident, under the definition of 87-2-102, who is 62 years or older shall be entitled to fish and hunt game birds with a conservation license issued by the department for a fee of \$1. The form of such license shall be prescribed by the department.

~~(2) A person described in subsection (1) is also entitled to purchase regular resident deer and elk tags at a price that is no more than one-half of the fee paid by a resident who is 15 years old or older and who is under 62 years of age.~~"
