Section 1. Designation of holidays by board of regents. (1) The board of regents of higher education may, subject to collective bargaining agreements, designate the following business days as holidays for nonacademic staff members of the university system in exchange for the same number of legal holidays enumerated in 1-1-216:

- (a) the Friday following Thanksgiving;
- 17 (b) the Monday before Christmas Day or New Year's Day 13 if either holiday falls on Tuesday; and
- 19 (c) the Friday after Christmas Day or New Year's Day
- 20 if either holiday falls on Thursday.
- 21 (2) A full-time employee who is scheduled for a day
  22 off on a day that is designated as a holiday under
  23 subsection (1) is entitled to receive another day off during
  24 the week of the designated holiday in addition to the
  25 employee's regularly scheduled days off- Part-time employees

- 1 receive paid holiday time off during the week of the
