4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO MAKE THE LIMITATION
5 ON GOVERNMENTAL LIABILITIES FOR DAMAGES APPLY ONLY TO ACTS
6 ARISING OUT OF A GOVERNMENTAL FUNCTION; AMENDING SECTION
7 2-9-102, MCA."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 2-9-102, MCA, is amended to read:
11 "2-9-102. Governmental entities liable for torts
12 except as specifically provided by legislature. Every
13 governmental entity is subject to liability for its torts
14 and those of its employees acting within the scope of their
15 employment or duties whether arising out of a governmental
16 or--proprietary function except as specifically provided by
17 the legislature under Article II, section 18, of The
18 Constitution of the State of Montana."
