A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ALLOWING THE BOARD OF
PARDONS TO DELEGATE CERTAIN HEARING FUNCTIONS; AMENDING
SECTION 46-23-104, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 46-23-104, MCA, is amended to read:

"46-23-104. Board of pardons. (1) The board of pardons
is responsible for executive clemency and parole as provided
in this chapter.

(2) The board shall meet at least twice each month at
the state prison.

(3) The principal office of the board shall be in Deer
Lodge.

~~(4) The board may designate one of its members, one of
its staff members, or any other adult correctional releasing
authority to conduct interviews relative to parole
eligibility, plans for release on parole, or revocation
