1           2           INTRODUCED BY Edward W. Anderson

3           4           A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REMOVE MOTORCYCLES  
5           FROM THE LIST OF VEHICLES THAT ARE EXEMPT FROM THE  
6           PROVISIONS OF THE MANDATORY LIABILITY PROTECTION LAW  
7           GOVERNING OWNERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES; AMENDING SECTION  
8           61-6-303, MCA."

9           10          BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11           Section 1. Section 61-6-303, MCA, is amended to read:  
12           "61-6-303. Exempt vehicles. The following vehicles and  
13           their drivers are exempt from the provisions of 61-6-301:

14           (1) a vehicle owned by the United States government or  
15           any state or political subdivision;

16           (2) a vehicle for which cash, securities, or a bond  
17           has been deposited or filed with the division upon such  
18           terms and conditions providing the same benefits available  
19           under a required motor vehicle liability insurance policy;

20           (3) a vehicle owned by a self-insurer certified as  
21           provided in 61-6-143;

22           (4) an implement of husbandry or special mobile  
23           equipment that is only incidentally operated on a highway or  
24           property open to use by the public;

25           (5) a vehicle operated upon a highway only for the

1           1           purpose of crossing such highway from one property to  
2           another;

3           3           (6) a commercial vehicle registered or proportionally  
4           registered in this and any other jurisdiction provided that  
5           vehicle is covered by a motor vehicle liability insurance  
6           policy complying with the laws of another jurisdiction in  
7           which it is registered;

9           9           ~~(8) all~~ a vehicle moved solely by human or animal
