A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT DEFINING THE AUTHORITY

OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO CREATE RURAL SPECIAL

IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS THAT FUND IMPROVEMENTS ON

UNDERDEVELOPED AND UNDCCUPIED PARCELS OF LAND THAT ARE BEING

SUBDIVIDED: AMENDING SECTION 7-12-2102, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-12-2102, MCA, is amended to read:

"7-12-2102. Authorization to create rural improvement districts upon petition. (11) Whenever the public interest or convenience may require and upon the petition of 60% of the fraeholders affected thereby, the board of county commissioners is hereby authorized and empowered to order and create special improvement districts in thickly populated localities outside of the limits of incorporated towns and cities for the purpose of building, constructing, or acquiring by purchase devices intended to protect the safety of the public from open ditches carrying irrigation or other water and maintaining sanitary and storm sewers, light systems, waterworks plants, water systems, sidewalks, and such other special improvements as may be petitioned for.

1 (2) The term "thickly populated localities" used in
2 subsection (1) refers to the proposed special improvement
3 district at the time it is petitioned for It does not refer
4 to the general area in which the special improvement
5 district would be located."
