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A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING CEPTIFICATION BY THE COUNTY TREASURER THAT THERE ARE NO DELINQUENT TAXES OUTSTANDING ON PROPERTY PROPOSED TO BE SUBDIVIDED; AMENDING SECTION 76-B-611. NCA.\*

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 76-3-611, MCA, is amended to read: \*76-3-611. Review of final plat. (1) The governing 12 body shall examine every final subdivision plat and shall 13 approve it when and only when:

1al it conforms to the conditions of approval set forth on the preliminary plat and to the terms of this chapter and regulations adopted pursuant thereto: and

(b) the county treasurer has certified that no real property taxes assessed and levied on the land to be subdivided are delinquent.

(2) (a) The governing body may require that final subdivision plats and certificates of survey be reviewed for errors and omissions in calculation or drafting by an examining land surveyor before recording with the county clark and recorder. When the survey data shown on the plat or certificate of survey meats the conditions set forth by

or pursuant to this chapter, the examining land surveyor shall so certify in a printed or stamped certificate on the 3 plat or certificate of survey. Such certificate shall be signed by him.

5 (b) No land surveyor shall act as an examining land surveyor in regard to a plat or certificate of survey in 7 which he has a financial or personal interest."
