INTRODUCED BY

BY REQUEST OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUDIT COMMITTEE

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ELIMINATE REFERENCES TO THE BOARD OF SANITARIANS; REPEALING SECTIONS 2-15-1631, 37-40-101, 37-40-102, 37-40-201 THROUGH 37-40-203, 37-40-301 THROUGH 37-40-307, 37-40-311, AND 37-40-312, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

WHEREAS, the sunset law, sections 2-8-103 and 2-8-112, MCA, terminates the Board of Sanitarians and requires a performance evaluation of the Board by the Legislative Audit Committee; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the performance evaluation, the Legislative Audit Committee recommends that the Board of Sanitarians be abolished.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Repealer. Sections 2-15-1631, 37-40-101, 37-40-102, 37-40-201 through 37-40-203, 37-40-301 through 37-40-307, 37-40-311, and 37-40-312, MCA, are repealed.

Section 2. Effective date. This act is effective July 1, 1981, except that for the purpose of winding up the affairs of the board, the sections repealed have effect in

1 accordance with 2-8-121.
