4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE COUNTIES
5 TO ESTABLISH PROGRAMS FOR NEUTERING DOGS AND CATS;
6 AUTHORIZING THE LEVYING OF A GENERAL TAX OF ONE MILL FOR
7 IMPLEMENTATION OF A DOG AND CAT NEUTERING PROGRAM."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. County dog and cat neutering program. (1)
11 The governing body of a county may establish a program for
12 the neutering of dogs and cats.

13 (2) The governing body may contract with a recognized
14 local organization established for the humane treatment of
15 animals to administer the dog and cat neutering program.

16 (3) If a program is established pursuant to subsection
17 (1), residents of the county who own dogs and cats may apply
18 to the county or its agent for reimbursement of money spent
19 for the neutering of their dogs and cats by licensed
20 veterinarians.

21 (4) To raise revenue for the implementation and
22 operation of the dog and cat neutering program, each
23 governing body may annually levy a special tax upon the
24 taxable property in the county of not more than 1 mill,
25 payable to the county treasurer.

1 (5) All money collected under subsection (4) must be
2 deposited in the county dog and cat neutering fund.
