9 for payments, the content of any application form, and any

11 (2) determine equitably the amount that is due each 12 local government that applies for a state payment, based on 13 the rules adopted under subsection (1) and the availability 14 of funds;

15 (3) disburse any state payments to local governments,
16 as detarmined under this section, no later than October 1 of
17 each year; and

18 (4) ensure that the total state payment to local
19 governments in any year does not exceed the fiscal year
20 appropriation for this purpose.

State payment received by local government. 22 Any state payment to a local government for fire protection 23 or law enforcement services for state-owned property must be 24 applied by the local government to offset the costs of 25 providing fire protection or law enforcement services.

In compliance with a written request received <u>February 10</u>, 19 <u>81</u>, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>Senate Bill 417</u> pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

Description of Proposed Legislation

An act to provide for state payments to local governments that provide fire protection and law enforcement services for state owned property.

Fiscal Impact

This bill provides that the Department of Administration develop rules and procedures for calculating payments to local governments for police and fire services since the methodology that would be used by the department is unknown at this time. No fiscal impact can be calculated.

However, Governor Schwinden has budgeted \$ 1,500,000 for each year of the biennium to fund this bill. It is intended that the department would develop a reimbursement scheme costing no more than this amount.
