 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Section 18-6-101, MCA, is amended to read:

12 "18-6-101. Power to sell state property -- proceeds
 13 credited to general fund. (1) The department has exclusive
 14 power, subject to the approval of the governor, to sell or
 15 otherwise dispose of or to authorize the sale or other
 16 disposition of all materials and supplies, service
 17 equipment, or other personal property of every kind owned by
 18 the state but not needed or used by any state institution or
 19 by any department of state government.

20 (2) Unless otherwise provided by law, the department
 21 shall credit the general fund with all money received.

22 ~~(3) Whenever the personal property was accounted for~~
 23 ~~in a revolving fund account, the proceeds of the sale shall~~
 24 ~~be credited to the appropriate revolving fund account."~~
