A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PERMIT THE QUALIFICATION OF SERVICE TIME BETWEEN THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES', HIGHWAY PATROLMEN'S, SHERIFFS', GAME WARDENS', AND MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEMS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Qualification of service from other Montana public retirement systems. (1) A member may, at any time before his retirement, make a written election with the board to qualify all or any portion of his creditable service in the highway patrolmen's, sheriffs', game wardens', or municipal police officers' retirement system for which he has received a refund of his membership contributions. To qualify this service, he must contribute to the retirement fund the actuarial cost of granting the service in the public employees' retirement system as determined by the board based on his compensation earned as a member of the former system and the normal contribution rate according to the most recent actuarial valuation minus the employer contribution provided in subsection (2). This service may not be credited in more than one retirement system under Title 19.

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(2) Upon receiving the member's payment under subsection (1), the administrator shall transfer from the member's former retirement system to the public employees' retirement system an amount equal to the employer contributions made during the member's service but no more than an amount equal to the normal contribution rate minus the employee contribution rate in the public employees' retirement system, according to the most recent actuarial valuation, based on the salaries earned by the employee as a member of the former system.

(3) Service qualified under subsections (1) and (2) may not be used for qualification under 19-3-507.

Section 2. Qualification of service from other Montana public retirement systems. (1) A member may, at any time before his retirement, make a written election with the board to qualify all or any portion of his creditable service in the public employees', sheriffs', game wardens', or municipal police officers' retirement system for which he has received a refund of his membership contributions. To qualify this service, he must contribute to the retirement fund the actuarial cost of granting the service in the highway patrolmen's retirement system as determined by the board based on his compensation earned as a member of the former system and the normal contribution rate according to the most recent actuarial valuation minus the employer

1 contribution provided in subsection (2). This service may
2 not be credited in more than one retirement system under
3 Title 19.

4 (2) Upon receiving the member's payment under
5 subsection (1), the administrator shall transfer from the
6 member's former retirement system to the highway patrolmen's
7 retirement system an amount equal to the employer
8 contributions made during the member's service but no more
9 than an amount equal to the normal contribution rate minus
10 the employee contribution rate in the highway patrolmen's
11 retirement system, according to the most recent actuarial
12 valuation, based on the salaries earned by the employee as a
13 member of the former system.

14 Section 3. Qualification of service from other Montana
15 public retirement systems. (1) A member may, at any time
16 before his retirement, make a written election with the
17 board to qualify all or any portion of his creditable
18 service in the public employees', highway patrolmen's, game
19 wardens', or municipal police officers' retirement system
20 for which he has received a refund of his membership
21 contributions. To qualify this service, he must contribute
22 to the retirement fund the actuarial cost of granting the
23 service in the sheriffs' retirement system as determined by
24 the board based on his compensation earned as a member of

11 the employee contribution rate in the sheriffs' retirement
12 system, according to the most recent actuarial valuation,
13 based on the salaries earned by the employee as a member of
14 the former system.

15 Section 4. Qualification of service from other Montana
16 public retirement systems. (1) A member may, at any time
17 before his retirement, make a written election with the
18 board to qualify all or any portion of his creditable
19 service in the public employees', highway patrolmen's,
20 sheriffs', or municipal police officers' retirement system
21 for which he has received a refund of his membership
22 contributions. To qualify this service, he must contribute
23 to the retirement fund the actuarial cost of granting the
24 service in the game wardens' retirement system as determined
25 by the board based on his compensation earned as a member of

1 the former system and the normal contribution rate according
 2 to the most recent actuarial valuation minus the employer
 3 contribution provided in subsection (2). This service may
 4 not be credited in more than one retirement system under
 5 Title 19.

6 (2) Upon receiving the member's payment under
 7 subsection (1), the administrator shall transfer from the
 8 member's former retirement system to the game wardens'
 9 retirement system an amount equal to the employer
 10 contributions made during the member's service but no more
 11 than an amount equal to the normal contribution rate minus
 12 the employee contribution rate in the game wardens'
 13 retirement system, according to the most recent actuarial
 14 valuation, based on the salaries earned by the employee as a
 15 member of the former system.

16 Section 5. Qualification of service from other Montana
 17 public retirement systems. (1) A member may, at any time
 18 before his retirement, make a written election with the
 19 board to qualify all or any portion of his creditable
 20 service in the public employees', highway patrolmen's,
 21 sheriffs', or game wardens' retirement system for which he
 22 has received a refund of his membership contributions. To
 23 qualify this service, he must contribute to the retirement
 24 fund the actuarial cost of granting the service in the
 25 municipal police officers' retirement system as determined

1 by the board based on his compensation earned as a member of
 2 the former system and the normal contribution rate according
 3 to the most recent actuarial valuation minus the employer
 4 contribution provided in subsection (2). This service may
 5 not be credited in more than one retirement system under
 6 Title 19.

7 (2) Upon receiving the member's payment under
 8 subsection (1), the administrator shall transfer from the
 9 member's former retirement system to the municipal police
 10 officers' retirement system an amount equal to the employer
 11 contributions made during the member's service but no more
 12 than an amount equal to the normal contribution rate minus
 13 the employee contribution rate in the municipal police
 14 officers' retirement system, according to the most recent
 15 actuarial valuation, based on the salaries earned by the
 16 employee as a member of the former system.

17 Section 6. Codification instruction. (1) Section 1 is
 18 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 19,
 19 chapter 3, part 5, and the provisions of Title 19, chapter
 20 3, apply to section 1.

21 (2) Section 2 is intended to be codified as an
 22 integral part of Title 19, chapter 6, part 3, and the
 23 provisions of Title 19, chapter 6, apply to section 2.

24 (3) Section 3 is intended to be codified as an
 25 integral part of Title 19, chapter 7, part 3, and the

17 board to qualify all or any portion of his creditable
18 service in the public employees', sheriffs', game wardens',
19 or municipal police officers' retirement system for which he
20 has received a refund of his membership contributions. To
21 qualify this service, he must contribute to the retirement
22 fund the actuarial cost of granting the service in the
23 highway patrolmen's retirement system as determined by the
24 board based on his compensation earned as a member of the
25 former system and the normal contribution rate according to

1 the most recent actuarial valuation minus the employer
 2 contribution provided in subsection (2). This service may
 3 not be credited in more than one retirement system under
 4 Title 19.

5 (2) Upon receiving the member's payment under
 6 subsection (1), the administrator shall transfer from the
 7 member's former retirement system to the highway patrolmen's
 8 retirement system an amount equal to the employer
 9 contributions made during the member's service but no more
 10 than an amount equal to the normal contribution rate minus
 11 the employee contribution rate in the highway patrolmen's
 12 retirement system, according to the most recent actuarial
 13 valuation, based on the salaries earned by the employee as a
 14 member of the former system.

15 Section 3. Qualification of service from other Montana
 16 public retirement systems. (1) A member may, at any time
 17 before his retirement, make a written election with the
 18 board to qualify all or any portion of his creditable
 19 service in the public employees', highway patrolmen's, game
 20 wardens', or municipal police officers' retirement system
 21 for which he has received a refund of his membership
 22 contributions. To qualify this service, he must contribute
 23 to the retirement fund the actuarial cost of granting the
 24 service in the sheriffs' retirement system as determined by
 25 the board based on his compensation earned as a member of

1 the former system and the normal contribution rate according
 2 to the most recent actuarial valuation minus the employer
 3 contribution provided in subsection (2). This service may
 4 not be credited in more than one retirement system under
 5 Title 19.

6 (2) Upon receiving the member's payment under
 7 subsection (1), the administrator shall transfer from the
 8 member's former retirement system to the sheriffs'
 9 retirement system an amount equal to the employer
 10 contributions made during the member's service but no more
 11 than an amount equal to the normal contribution rate minus
 12 the employee contribution rate in the sheriffs' retirement
 13 system, according to the most recent actuarial valuation,
 14 based on the salaries earned by the employee as a member of
 15 the former system.

16 Section 4. Qualification of service from other Montana
 17 public retirement systems. (1) A member may, at any time
 18 before his retirement, make a written election with the
 19 board to qualify all or any portion of his creditable
 20 service in the public employees', highway patrolmen's,
 21 sheriffs', or municipal police officers' retirement system
 22 for which he has received a refund of his membership
 23 contributions. To qualify this service, he must contribute
 24 to the retirement fund the actuarial cost of granting the
 25 service in the game wardens' retirement system as determined

1 by the board based on his compensation earned as a member of
 2 the former system and the normal contribution rate according
 3 to the most recent actuarial valuation minus the employer
 4 contribution provided in subsection (2). This service may
 5 not be credited in more than one retirement system under
 6 Title 19.

7 (2) Upon receiving the member's payment under
 8 subsection (1), the administrator shall transfer from the
 9 member's former retirement system to the game wardens'
 10 retirement system an amount equal to the employer
 11 contributions made during the member's service but no more
 12 than an amount equal to the normal contribution rate minus
 13 the employee contribution rate in the game wardens'
 14 retirement system, according to the most recent actuarial
 15 valuation, based on the salaries earned by the employee as a
 16 member of the former system.

17 Section 5. Qualification of service from other Montana
 18 public retirement systems. (1) A member may, at any time
 19 before his retirement, make a written election with the
 20 board to qualify all or any portion of his creditable
 21 service in the public employees', highway patrolmen's,
 22 sheriffs', or game wardens' retirement system for which he
 23 has received a refund of his membership contributions. To
 24 qualify this service, he must contribute to the retirement
 25 fund the actuarial cost of granting the service in the

1 municipal police officers' retirement system as determined
 2 by the board based on his compensation earned as a member of
 3 the former system and the normal contribution rate according
 4 to the most recent actuarial valuation minus the employer
 5 contribution provided in subsection (2). This service may
 6 not be credited in more than one retirement system under
 7 Title 19.

8 (2) Upon receiving the member's payment under
 9 subsection (1), the administrator shall transfer from the
 10 member's former retirement system to the municipal police
 11 officers' retirement system an amount equal to the employer
 12 contributions made during the member's service but no more
 13 than an amount equal to the normal contribution rate minus
 14 the employee contribution rate in the municipal police
 15 officers' retirement system, according to the most recent
 16 actuarial valuation, based on the salaries earned by the
 17 employee as a member of the former system.

18 Section 6. Codification instruction. (1) Section 1 is
 19 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 19,
 20 chapter 3, part 5, and the provisions of Title 19, chapter
 21 3, apply to section 1.

22 (2) Section 2 is intended to be codified as an
 23 integral part of Title 19, chapter 6, part 3, and the
 24 provisions of Title 19, chapter 6, apply to section 2.

25 (3) Section 3 is intended to be codified as an

1 integral part of Title 19, chapter 7, part 3, and the
2 provisions of Title 19, chapter 7, apply to section 3.

3 (4) Section 4 is intended to be codified as an
4 integral part of Title 19, chapter 8, part 3, and the
5 provisions of Title 19, chapter 8, apply to section 4.

6 (5) Section 5 is intended to be codified as an
7 integral part of Title 19, chapter 9, part 4, and the
8 provisions of Title 19, chapter 9, apply to section 5.

9 SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE. THIS ACT IS EFFECTIVE ON
10 PASSAGE AND APPROVAL.
