A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE COUNTY ASSESSOR TO RELEASE THE ROLLBACK TAX LIEN WHEN THE ROLLBACK TAX HAS BEEN PAID; AMENDING SECTION 15-7-209, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 15-7-209, MCA, is amended to read:

"15-7-209. Reclassification by owner ~~-- lien.~~ (1)

Whenever land which is or has been in agricultural use and is or has been valued, assessed, and taxed for agricultural use is applied to a use other than agricultural, the owner shall notify the county assessor and the county assessor shall cause the following statement to be recorded by the county clerk and recorder: "On the day of, 19... this land became subject to the rollback tax imposed by 15-7-204."

~~(2) Upon collection of the rollback tax, the county treasurer shall certify the collection to the county assessor. The county assessor shall execute a release of lien, in a manner eligible for recording, and record the release in the office of the clerk and recorder."~~

GOVERNOR'S PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 460;
REFERENCE COPY, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Title, lines 5 and 6
Following: "LIEN"
Strike: "WHEN THE ROLLBACK TAX HAS BEEN PAID"

2. Page 1, lines 19 through 23
Following: "(2)"
Strike: remainder of lines 19 through 23 in their entirety
Insert: "The county assessor shall execute, in a form eligible
for recording, releases of lien, for those liens
attributable to the former rollback tax, and the
assessor shall record the releases in the office of
the clerk and recorder."
