4 A RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA
 5 AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE TO APPROVE THE
 6 EMPLOYMENT OF SENATE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES NECESSARY TO
 7 COMPLETE THE BUSINESS OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE 47TH
 8 LEGISLATURE AND TO PROVIDE COMPENSATION FOR EMPLOYEES TO
 9 PREPARE ANY BUSINESS OF ANY SPECIAL SESSION OF THE 47TH
 10 LEGISLATURE.

 12 WHEREAS, the completion of business of the regular
 13 session of the 47th Legislature encompasses the employment
 14 of certain legislative officers and employees of the Senate;
 15 and

16 WHEREAS, the preparation of business of any special
 17 session of the 47th Legislature encompasses the employment
 18 of certain legislative officers and employees of the Senate.

 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
 21 MONTANA:

22 That the President of the Senate or his designee is
 23 authorized by the Senate Committee on Legislative
 24 Administration and the Senate of the 47th Legislature to
 25 employ and continue the employment of officers and employees

1 necessary to complete all unfinished business incident to
 2 and consequent upon the 47th Legislature and any special
 3 session of the 47th Legislature.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the payrolls covering each
 5 employment shall be authenticated by the President of the
 6 Senate or his designee and the Director, Accounting
 7 Division, Legislative Council, and payment of the same shall
 8 be made separate and out of funds appropriated for the
 9 regular session of the 47th Legislature at the rate
 10 specified in House Joint Resolution No. 3 effective January
 11 19, 1981, or from any new funds appropriated for such
 12 purposes.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that legislative officers and
 14 employees for any special session of the 47th Legislature
 15 shall be employed and compensated at the same prescribed
 16 rate as defined in House Joint Resolution No. 3.
