9 WHEREAS, much difficulty has been experienced in  
10 locating stored supplies and furniture belonging to the  
11 Senate; and

12 WHEREAS, some articles of furniture have not yet been  
13 located, and the use of Senate furniture by other state  
14 departments during the interim has caused confusion and some  
15 damage.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF  
18 MONTANA:

19 That all small supplies and typewriters belonging to  
20 the Senate of the State of Montana be boxed, labeled, and  
21 stored under lock and key in room 407 of the Capitol  
22 Building.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all furniture belonging to  
24 the Senate remain in the particular offices and committee  
25 rooms of the Senate and shall not be removed from the

2 interim.

23    BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT THE SERGEANT-AT-ARMS OF  
24   THE SENATE SHALL INVENTORY ALL OF THE ITEMS OF FURNITURE IN  
25   EACH INDIVIDUAL OFFICE AND COMMITTEE ROOM OF THE SENATE AND

1    that all furniture belonging to the Senate remain in the  
2   particular offices and committee rooms of the Senate and  
3   shall not be removed from the various offices and committee  
4   rooms of the Senate during the interim; AND  
5    BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION  
6    SHALL BE DELIVERED TO THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF  
7    ADMINISTRATION, AS A FORMAL REQUEST OF THE SENATE, THAT THE  
8    SENATE FURNITURE REMAIN LOCKED IN THE ROOMS DURING THE  
9    INTERIM.
