DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 21 provides for license plate stickers to be issued to handicapped persons who own motor vehicles.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1) 500 permits were issued in 1981 with no measurable increase expected.
- 2) Due to the supply of permits on hand, no outlay is necessary to comply with 49-4-301(1)(b).
- 3) Operating expense is based on the cost of license plate month stickers—the most economical purchase is based on the purchase of 9500 stickers.
