BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Improperly loaded vehicle — exception. (1)

A person may not drive or move any vehicle on any highway
unless the vehicle is so constructed or its load is so
secured as to prevent its contents from dropping, sifting,
leaking, or otherwise escaping IF SUCH CONTENTS CREATE A
HAZARDOUS SITUATION FOR OTHER MOTORISTS.

(2) This provision does not prevent the necessary
spreading of any substance in highway maintenance or
construction.

Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is
intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 61,
chapter 8, part 3, and the provisions of Title 61, chapter
8, apply to section 1.
