7    COMMITTEE THEIR RECOMMENDATIONS FOR LEGISLATION CLARIFYING  
8    GRANTS OF RULEMAKING AUTHORITY; AMENDING SECTION 2-4-314,  
9    MCA."

11   BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
12        Section 1. Section 2-4-314, MCA, is amended to read:  
13        "2-4-314. Biennial review by agencies -- report  
14        ~~recommendations by committee.~~ (1) Each agency shall at least  
15        biennially review its rules to determine if any new rule  
16        should be adopted or any existing rule should be modified or  
17        repealed.  
18        ~~(2) -- Prior to October 1, 1980, and prior to October 1~~  
19        ~~of each even-numbered year thereafter, each agency shall~~  
20        ~~prepare and submit a report to the administrative code~~  
21        ~~committee in tabular or other form indicating the agency's~~  
22        ~~recommendations for legislation which will clarify existing~~  
23        ~~grants of rulemaking authority and grant or eliminate~~  
24        ~~rulemaking authority as necessary.~~  
25        (3) (2) The committee may recommend to the legislature

1    those modifications, additions, or deletions of agency  
2    rulemaking authority which the committee considers  
3    necessary."
