HOUSE BILL NO. 55

INTRODUCED BY KITSSELMAN

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT APPROPRIATING MONEY TO THE LEGISLATURE FOR THE VIDEOTAPING OF THE 48TH LEGISLATIVE SESSION; AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO CONTRACT FOR THE VIDEOTAPING; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation for videotaping. (1) There is appropriated from the general fund to the 48th Legislature \$75,000 for the purpose of establishing a video record of the 48th Legislative Session.

(2) The president of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives may contract to provide for the establishment of a videotape record system and maintenance thereof. The contract should provide for taping of all Committee of the Whole sessions and such committee hearings as considered appropriate.

Section 2. Effective date. This act is effective on passage and approval.
