 4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING SECTION
 5 2-15-1009, MCA, TO ADD A RETIRED PUBLIC EMPLOYEE TO THE
 6 PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT BOARD; AND PROVIDING AN
 7 IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 2-15-1009, MCA, is amended to read:
 11 "2-15-1009. Public employees' retirement board --
 12 terms -- allocation. (1) There is a public employees'
 13 retirement board.

14 (2) The board consists of ~~five~~ six members appointed
 15 by the governor. The members are:

16 (a) three public employees who are active members of a
 17 public retirement system (not more than one of these members
 18 may be an employee of the same department); and

19 (b) one retired public employee who is an inactive
 20 member of the public employees' retirement system; and

21 ~~(b)(c)~~ two members at large.

22 (3) The term of office for each member is 5 years.

23 (4) The board is allocated to the department for
 24 administrative purposes only as prescribed in 2-15-121.

25 (5) Members of the board shall be paid their travel

1 expenses as provided for in 2-18-501 through 2-18-503, as
 2 amended, and members of the board who are not active members
 3 of the public retirement system shall be entitled, in
 4 addition to travel expenses, to compensation as established
 5 for a quasi-judicial board in 2-15-124."

6 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Initial appointment of
 7 retired public employee. The governor shall appoint the
 8 retired public employee provided for in 2-15-1009 within 30
 9 days after the effective date of this act.

10 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. This act is
 11 effective on passage and approval.
