A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: MAN ACT TO ALLOW A CERTIFIED SCHOOL EMPLOYEE TO ADMINISTER A PRESCRIBED MEDICINE TO A STUDENT ACCORDING TO A DOCTORS INSTRUCTIONS ON THE MEDICINE AND WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE PARENT .W
be it enacted by the legislature of the state of montana:
Section 1. Administration of prescribed medicine by certified school employee. (1) A certified school employee may administer a prescribed medicine to the student for whom it is prescribed, if:
(a) the certified school employee elects to administer such a prescribed medicine; and
(b) the administration is in compliance, with [section 2] and with the written instructions of the prescribing physician on the medicine.
(2) A school nurse or certified school employee who in good faith administers a prescribed medicine to a student in compliance with [section 2] and with the written instructions of the physician on the prescribed medicine is not liable for civil damages as a result of the administration except for an act or omission constituting gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct.

Section 2. Written permission from parent or guardian -- possession of medicine. (1) The parent or guardian must give written permission for the administration of the prescribed medicine at school.
(2) At no time may any school employee allow the student or any other student to have possession of the prescribed medicine.

Section 3. Codification instruction. Sections 1 and 2 are intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 20. chapter 4: part 3, and the provisions of Title 20 apply to sections 1 and 2 .
