their customary range without the permission of the owner
thereof is punishable by imprisonment in the county jail not
exceeding 90 days or by fine not exceeding \$100, or both."

"81-5-102. Briving Moving animals upon railroad track.

If a person willfully drives moves or causes to be moved an animal upon a railroad track with intent to injure the corporation or persons owning the railroad and such animal is killed or injured thereby, the person is punishable by a fine not exceeding \$50,000 or imprisonment in the state prison not exceeding 5 years, or both, and is liable for all
