mark or brand. The department shall charge \$2.50 for a  
certified copy of a record and a duplicate certificate. The  
department may upon request research mark or brand histories  
and may charge a fee of up to \$50 per mark or brand, based  
on time involved in research. All fees collected shall be  
paid into the earmarked revenue fund for the use of the  
department. However, not more than 10% of the net  
rerecording fees after all expenses of rerecording are paid

In compliance with a written request received January 10, , 19 83 , there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 113 pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA).

Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 113 allows the Department of Livestock to charge up to \$50.00 to research the history of a mark or brand.


ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1) There will be requests to research 30 marks and brands each year.
- 2) The average salary of the employees conducting the research will be \$9 per hour.
- 3) Time required to research each mark or brand will average 4 hours.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The department projects a cost of \$1,080 each year for requested brand research. The department has the authority to charge fees commensurate with costs, up to \$50 per mark or brand. Therefore the net effect is no impact.
