DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 136 deletes the requirement that the fund balance at the end of biennium in the motor vehicle recording account be deposited in the general fund. It has an immediate effective date.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1) In FY 82, \$557,973 was transferred from the account to the general fund. In FY 83, approximately \$254,443 would be transferred under existing law.
- 2) Current revenue estimates for the account are:

FY 84 3,059,750 FY 85 3,084,750

3) Because no appropriations have yet been approved for FY 84 and FY 85, it is impossible to estimate the balance that would be transferred in FY 84 and FY 85. The Executive Budget recommends that this balance instead be used to offset general fund expenses within the Department of Justice.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no net loss to the general fund.
