10 WHEREAS, the Presidential Disaster Declaration
11 (FEMA-640-DR-MT) in 1981 entitled the state of Montana to
12 federal disaster relief funds to assist flood victims; and

13 WHEREAS, in 1981 the Governor of the state of Montana
14 entered into a federal-state agreement with the Federal
15 Emergency Management Agency to enable the state to receive
16 federal disaster assistance under the Individual and Family
17 Grant Program; and

18 WHEREAS, a state participating in the Individual and
19 Family Grant Program is required to pay 25% of the cost of
20 the program; and

21 WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency agreed
22 to advance the full cost of this program to provide
23 immediate assistance to flood victims, with the stipulation
24 that the Governor request the 48th Legislature to
25 appropriate an amount equal to the state's share of the

1 program's cost; and

2 WHEREAS, the state's share of the grant program amounts
3 to \$133,130.37 according to a recent federal audit.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

6 Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated
7 \$133,130.37 from the general fund to the Governor's office
8 to pay the state's share of the Individual and Family Grant
9 Program providing assistance to flood victims.
