The registration form for each elector shall be assigned a number by the election administrator, using a system of numbering that best accommodates the filing system and list preparation method used. The However, the election administrator may not adopt the use of the elector's social security number as the registration number. If social security numbers are used, they may not be printed on lists of registered votors or released as public information.

(2) If secial security numbers and used as the registration number, the election administrator may assign an alternative number for any elector who does not have a secial security number or who declines to provide the number. A system of assigning alternative numbers shall be developed in consultation with the secretory of states.
