5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT MAKING IT A FELONY FOR
6 THE DRIVER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE TO ATTEMPT TO ELUDE A PURSUING
7 POLICE VEHICLE."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
10 Section 1. Attempting to elude pursuing police
11 vehicle. Any driver of a motor vehicle who purposely or
12 knowingly flees or attempts to elude a pursuing police
13 vehicle, as defined in 61-1-118, that is making use of an
14 audible or visual signal meeting the requirements of
15 61-9-402, shall be punished by imprisonment in the state
16 prison for not less than 1 year or more than 3 years or by a
17 fine of not less than \$500 or more than \$5,000.
18 Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is
19 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 45,
20 chapter 7, part 3, and the provisions of Title 45 apply to
21 section 1.
