BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Attempting to elude pursuing police vehicle. Any driver of a motor vehicle who purposely or knowingly flees or attempts to elude a pursuing police vehicle, as defined in 61-1-118, that is making use of an audible or visual signal meeting the requirements of 61-9-402, shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for not less than 1 year or more than 3 years or by a fine of not less than \$500 or more than \$5,000.

Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 45. chapter 7. part 3. and the provisions of Title 45 apply to section 1.
