BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated for  
each fiscal year ending June 30, 1984, and June 30, 1985, to  
the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services for  
area councils on aging, as provided for in 53-5-101, MCA, \$1  
million from the general fund. Allocation of funds to  
in-home services through area councils on aging must be  
based on a formula consistent with the requirements of Title  
III of the federal Older Americans Act.

1 ONLY SO MUCH OF THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN THIS BILL MAY BE  
 2 SPENT AS IS NEEDED TO SUPPLEMENT THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN  
 3 HB 898 TO RESULT IN \$300,000 BEING AVAILABLE FOR IN-HOME  
 4 SERVICES. Allocation of funds to in-home services through  
 5 area councils on aging must be based on a formula consistent  
 6 with the requirements of Title III of the federal Older
